Dogs have a sensitive hearing; they can hear sounds four times farther away than we can. They can hear higher frequency sounds and know where it is originating from. They can even differentiate sounds—that's why they know when your car has arrived. Humans can hear sounds that vibrate at less than 20,000 vibrations per second (20,000 Hz) while dogs can hear sounds of up to 50,000 vibrations per second (50,000 Hz). What's more? At high frequencies, dogs can hear much softer sounds. Thus, they can even hear sounds which cannot be heard by humans (less than 0 decibels).
