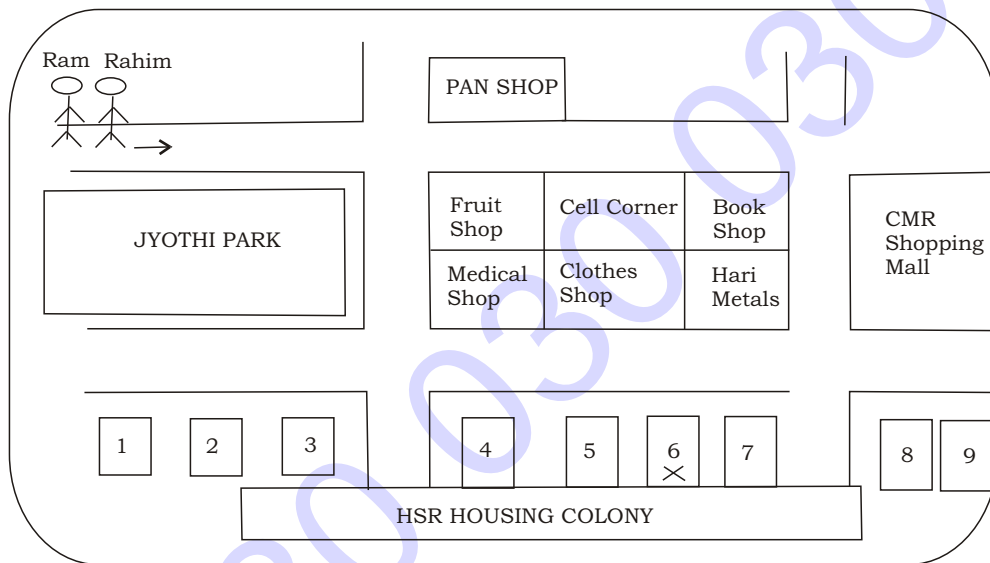

A passport is a document, issued by a national government, which certifies the identity and nationality of its holder for the purpose of international travel. If one wants to go to another country having a passport is a must. However, a passport does not of itself entitle the passport holder entry into another country, nor to consular protection while abroad nor any other privileges. One needs a visa to enter another country. The elements of identity contained in all standardized passports include information about the holder, including name, date of birth, gender and place of birth. Many countries issue only one passport to each national. When passport holders apply for a new passport (commonly, due to expiration of an old passport or lack of blank pages), they may be required to surrender the old passport for invalidation. In some circumstances an expired passport is not required to be surrendered or invalidated (for example, if it contains an unexpired visa).
