“There are more number of engineering colleges in AP than required.”

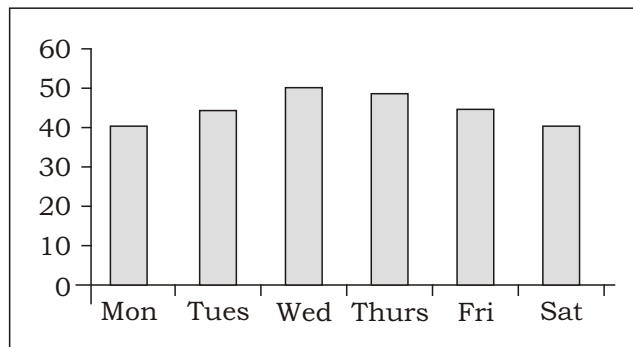
